The project

Area 2: Managers' Development Area focused on the development of individual Open Innovation Competencies required when managing activities in the scope of open innovation

Area 3: Open Innovation Repository - a data base about open innovation gathering tools already available and support measures for SMEs. It covers the target sector across all engaged countries and on EU level.


